Un Sarao de la Chacona is the only extant version of a chacona written as a score. This particular chacona is written by by the Catalan musician Juan Arañes who published the song in 1624.

The lyrics, with a Danish translation, are in the document "lyrics_un_sarao_de_la_chacona.pdf"

IMPORTANT!

We need to play this piece by heart by heart (without scores). Fortunately the instrumental structure is very simple.

The song is, instrumentally, composed of 3 different parts:

(The letters correspond to the rehearsal marks in the main score)

B: Intro, VERSION 1 (V1)

C: CHORUS

D: Copla VERSION 2 (composed of V1 followed by V2)

From E, the rest of the song is a repetition of CHORUS + VERSION 2, except for the two Pasacalles played by the guitar.

The lyrics are distributed between 4 singers:

Soprano I: Anna W

Soprano II: Julie and Anne E

Alto: Marta

as detailed below:

- A: Pasacalle, guitar "ad libitum"
- B: Intro (short verse, VERSION 1), soprano I: Anna W, sopran II: Julie, alto: Marta
- C: Chorus, soprano I: Anna W, sopran II: Julie, Anne E, alto: Marta

- E: **Chorus**, same distribution of voices as in C (the chorus has always the same distribution of voices)
- F: 2. Copla, alto: Marta
- G: Chorus, same distribution of voices as in C
- H: **3.** Copla, soprano I: Anna W
- I: **Chorus**, same distribution of voices as in C
- J: Pasacalle, guitars, viol, percussion, ad libitum
- K: 4. Copla, soprano I: Anna W, alto: Marta
- L: Chorus, same distribution of voices as in C
- M: **5.** Copla, soprano I: Anna W, alto: Marta alternate with all three voices (Anna, Marta, Julie), fermata on the word "Cid"
- N: Chorus, same distribution of voices as in C
- O: 6. Copla, soprano I: Anna W, alto: Marta alternate with all three voices (Anna, Marta, Julie)
- P: **Chorus**, same distribution of voices as in C, second half of chorus *dimin*. until whisper on the word 'chacona'
- Q+R: Pasacalle + dance section ad libitum
- S: 7. Copla, same distribution of voices as in B
- T: Chorus, same distribution of voices as in C
